 - approximately 25,000 to 45,000 words for a junior fiction book
 - no longer than 75,000 words for a young adult titleThe word length should be noted on title page.

All submissions will be treated in confidence and remain the intellectual property of the author.

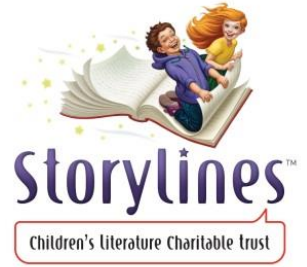
