

New Zealand citizens or permanent residents as defined here but who are living overseas temporarily are eligible if their absence is for LESS than two (2) years at the closing date for submissions.
- 2. I have not received or applied for any financial assistance towards this project.
- 3. This manuscript is not being considered for publication by any other publisher, company or organisation, either in book format or for online self-publishing.
- 4. This manuscript is an original piece of work i.e., written originally in te reo Māori by me, and has not appeared in any format i.e., has not been published (either by self-publishing or a small publishing house) in either print or digital format for trade (books sold through normal retail or online bookstores) or for educational purposes or be anywhere in the process of publication.
- 5. The manuscript is suitable for the chosen genre.

 - Approximately 25,000 to 45,000 for a junior fiction book
 - No longer than 75,000 for a young adult title
